# Test a new way of performing an action and measuring gain (Level 3) Example of an activity

# $Activity \ l - Choosing \ a \ strategy$

### Instruction

"You must remember the simplified protocol of a shower toilet. This protocol will be transmitted to you on a written medium without photos or drawings.

From the memorisation strategies you identified earlier in your group, choose one:

- that you don't usually use
- that seems effective to you in retaining the protocol of a shower"

#### Pooling of information

Ask everyone to name the strategy they have chosen.

Highlight that it is the situation that influences the choice of strategy.

### Activity 2 – Memorising a protocol

#### Instruction

"Memorise the protocol from toilet in the shower that is given to you.

You have X minutes."

### Variations:

- The trainer demonstrates the protocol
- The trainer reads the protocol
- The trainer proposes a protocol combining text and photos/drawings

<u>Remark</u>: participants need to know in advance in what form the protocol will be given to them to adapt their choice of strategy.

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Example of a partial protocol for shower toilet (Freely inspired by the syllabus of Tatiana Naryzhnyaya)

# 1) Preparation of the beneficiary

- Inform the beneficiary of what will be done and ask him about his condition before the treatment
- Physical
  - $\circ$   $\;$  Possibly present the breakdown, urinal or go to the toilet.
  - Ensure room temperature, close windows

## 2) Hand hygiene

- Hand washing (possibly, depending on the case, disinfection with hydro-alcoholic solution)

## 3) Gathering and preparation of the necessary material

- Gather all the equipment within reach

### 4) Installation of the beneficiary

- Invite him to go to the shower

### 5) <u>Execution of the technique</u>

- Undress the beneficiary
- Take the upper glove and wash the upper body
  - $\circ \quad \textbf{Facial cleansing}$
  - Upper limb, chest, abdomen and back grooming
- Take the bottom glove and wash the lower body
  - Lower limb toilet
  - o Intimate and seat toilet
- Dress the beneficiary
- Do the auxiliary care
- Invite the beneficiary to return to his chair/bed where he can be installed

### 6) <u>Re-ordering of equipment</u>

- 7) Hand washing
  - Disinfect with hydro-alcoholic solution
